

1x4 HDMI Splitter with 4Kx2K & EDID Management Installation Guide

Introduction

The 1x4 HDMI Splitter with 4Kx2K & EDID Management splits one HDMI signal to four HDMI displays at up to 4Kx2K resolution.

- HDMI IN: Connects to your HDMI source device by using an HDMI cable (cable not included)
- HDMI OUT 1-4 (left to right): Connects to your HDMI displays by using HDMI cables (cables not included)
- **F/W**: For future firmware update

- MODE: Selects alternate EDID modes and functions. See Mode Dial in page 4 & 5.
- DC 5V: Power adapter jack for the included
 5V power adapter

- **POWER LED:** On when the *Splitter* is powered on
- SIGNAL LED: On when HDMI source is detected

Hardware Installation

- 1. Power off all devices you plan to connect to the *Splitter*.
- 2. Connect your HDMI source's HDMI output to the *Splitter*'s **HDMI IN** using an HDMI cable (HDMI cable not included).

- 3. Connect your HDMI displays to the *Splitter*'s **HDMI OUT** using HDMI cables (HDMI cables not included).
- 4. Connect the included power adapter to the *Splitter*'s **DC 5V** power jack and plug it into a reliable power outlet.
- 5. Power on all of the connected devices.
- 6. The *Splitter* is now ready to use.

NOTE: To achieve 3D and 2Kx4K output, make sure this standard is supported by your display(s), and High Speed HDMI cables with Ethernet are used.

Mode Dial

EDID is used to transmit the make, model and characteristics of a monitor to the display adapter of the computer. It is also used by an HDTV to identify it's maximum resolution to the DVD player, A/V receiver or video processor. Use a flat head screwdriver to rotate the **Mode Dial** to select amongst the options.



- 0: Firmware update
- 1: EDID Full-HD (1080p@60) 24bit 2D video & 7.1ch audio
- 2: EDID Full-HD (1080p@60) 24bit 2D video & 2ch audio
- 3: EDID Full-HD (4K2K@30) 24bit 2D video & 7.1ch audio
- 4: EDID Full-HD (4K2K@30) 24bit 2D video
- 5: EDID HD (1080p@30)(1080i@60)(720p@ 60) - 24bit 2D video & 2ch audio
- 6: Auto EDID mode: Automatically detect and analyze the EDID of all the connected HDMI displays. The HDMI source player will defer to the lowest resolution HDMI display
- 7: EDID Learning mode: Learns the EDID of the HDMI display connected to **HDMI OUT** 1 of the *Splitter*




Figure 3: Application
