Layout




Figure 1. USB to Serial

Software Installation

Windows Driver Installation

For Windows 98/98SE:

- 1. Boot up to Windows and plug in the *USB to Serial* adapter.
- At the Add New Hardware Wizard, click Next.
- Select Search for the best driver for your device. (Recommended) and click Next.

- Insert the driver CD, check Specify a location, uncheck the other boxes, type in D:\Windows, then click Next. (Change D: to match your CD-ROM drive letter)
- 5. Click Next and Finish.
- 6. Restart Windows to complete the installation.

For Windows ME:

- 1. Boot up to Windows and plug in the *USB to Serial* adapter.
- Insert the driver CD. At the Add New Hardware Wizard, click Automatic Search for a better driver, then click Next.
- 3. Click Finish.
- 4. Restart Windows to complete the installation.

For Windows 2000:

- 1. Boot up to Windows and plug in the *USB to Serial* adapter.
- 2. At the Found New Hardware Wizard, click Next.
- Select Search for a suitable driver for my device (Recommended) and click Next.

- 4. Insert the driver CD, check **CD-ROM drives**, uncheck the other boxes, then click **Next**.
- 5. Click **Next** and **Finish**.
- 6. Repeat steps 2-5.
- 7. Restart Windows to complete the installation.

For Windows XP:

- 1. Boot up to Windows and plug in the *USB to Serial* adapter.
- Insert the driver CD. At the Found New Hardware Wizard, select Install the software automatically (Recommended), then click Next.
- 3. Click **Continue anyway**. Our driver has been thoroughly tested in Windows for stability.
- 4. Click Finish.
- 5. Repeat steps 2-4.
- 6. Restart Windows to complete the installation.

Verify Windows Installation

 Check **Device Manager** to verify successful driver installation.

<u>Windows 98/98SE/ME</u>: From the main desktop, right click **My Computer**, then click **Properties**. Click **Device Manager** tab.

<u>Windows 2000/XP</u>: Right click My Computer, then click Manage. Click Device Manager.

Double click Ports (COM & LPT) option and a USB to Serial (RS232).... should be displayed.

MAC OS 8.6/9.x Driver Installation

- Turn on your computer and insert the driver CD.
- Double click the **USBtoSerial** drive icon on the desktop.
- Double click MAC folder and two files appear. Copy these two files into the Extensions folder of your system hard drive.

Note: Extensions folder is located within **MAC HD\System Folder.**

4. Restart Windows to complete the installation.

Verify Mac OS Installation

- Check Apple System Profiler to verify successful installation.
- 2. Click the **Apple** icon on the desktop, then click **Apple System Profiler**.
- Click Devices and Volumes tab and the USB to Serial Converter should be listed.
