Quick Installation Guide

Introducing the *Parallel PCI-1P*

The *Parallel PCI-1P* high-speed parallel card provides one additional parallel port to your system. Depending on the model purchased, this board will fit into either Full or Low Profile chassis.

Features and Benefits

- Conforms to PCI v2.2 Plug and Play
- Supports 32-/64-bit, 3.3V/5V PCI and PCI-X slots
- Full support for Windows-based software
- Reduces CPU load and improves system performance dramatically
- Supports EPP/ECP, BPP (bi-directional), SPP (standard) parallel port modes

System Requirements

- Pentium or equivalent computer with an available 32-/64-bit PCI or PCI-X slot
- Windows 95/98/98SE/ME/NT 4.0/2000/XP/Server 2003

Package Contents

- *Parallel PCI-1P* board
- Low profile bracket (for *Dual Profile PCI-1P* only)
- Driver CD
- This quick installation guide

Layout

Depending on the model purchased, the bracket mounted on your board may vary from the image displayed.

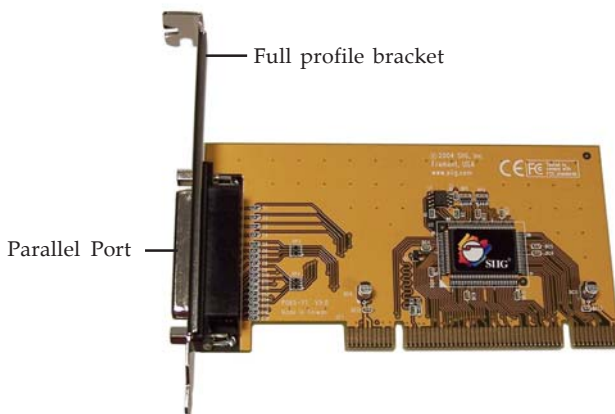


Figure 1. Layout

Hardware Installation

General instructions for installing the card are provided below. Since the design of computer cases and motherboards vary, refer to your computer's reference manual for further information, if needed.

Static Electricity Discharge may permanently damage your system. Discharge any static electricity build up in your body by touching your computer's case for a few seconds. Avoid any contact with internal parts and handle cards only by their external edges.

1. Turn OFF the power to your computer and any other connected peripheral devices.
2. Unplug the power cord from the back of the computer.

3. Remove your computer's cover.
4. Remove the slot bracket from an available PCI slot.
5. To install the card, carefully align the card's bus connector with the selected PCI slot on the motherboard. Push the board down firmly, but gently, until it is well seated.
6. Replace the slot bracket's holding screw to secure the card.
7. Replace the computer cover and reconnect the power cord.

Driver Installation

This section provides information on how to install the *Parallel PCI-1P* drivers.

Windows 95

1. At the **Update Device Driver Wizard**, click **Next**.
2. Insert the driver CD, and click **Other Locations**. Type in **D:\9x**, click **OK**, then **Finish**. (Change **D:** to match your CD-ROM drive letter)
3. From the **Insert Disk** window, click **OK**. When the **Copying Files** dialog box appears, type in **D:\9x**, then click **OK**. (Change **D:** to match your CD-ROM drive letter)
4. Restart Windows to complete the installation.

Windows 98/98SE

1. At the **Add New Hardware Wizard** window, click **Next**.
2. Select **Search for the best driver for your device. (Recommended)**, then click **Next**.

3. Select **Specify a location**, uncheck the other boxes, insert the driver CD, type in **D:\9x**, then click **Next**. (Change **D:** to match your CD-ROM drive letter)
4. Click **Next**, then **Finish**. If prompted, at the **Insert Disk** box click **OK**. Insert your Windows 98 Installation CD-ROM then click **OK**.
5. Restart Windows to complete the installation.

Windows ME

1. At the **Add New Hardware Wizard**, select **Specify the location of the driver (Advanced)**, then click **Next**.
2. Check **Specify a location**, uncheck the other box, insert the driver CD, type in **D:\Me**, then click **Next**. (Change **D:** to match your CD-ROM drive letter)
3. Click **Next**, then **Finish**.
4. Restart Windows to complete the installation.

To Verify Windows 95/98/98SE/ME Installation

1. From the main desktop, double click **My Computer**, **Control Panel**, **System**, then click **Device Manager**.
2. Double click **Ports (COM & LPT)**, **ECP Printer Port...** and **SIIG CyberPro 1P PCI board** should be displayed.

Windows NT 4.0

1. From the desktop click **Start**, then **Run**.
2. Insert the driver CD, type in **D:\NT4\Install_Parallel.exe**, then click **OK**. (Change **D:** to match your CD-ROM drive letter)

3. At the **Welcome** window, click **Next**.
4. Choose **Install**, then click **Next**.
5. Click **Yes**, then click **Exit**.
6. Click **Yes** to restart to complete the installation.

To Verify Windows NT 4.0 Installation

1. Click **Start, Programs, Administrative Tools**, then **Windows NT Diagnostics**.
2. Click **Resources** tab, **SIIGpar** should be displayed.

Windows 2000

1. At the **Found New Hardware Wizard**, click **Next**.
2. Select **Search for a suitable driver for my device (recommended)**, then click **Next**.
3. Select **Specify a location**, uncheck the other options and click **Next**.
4. Insert the driver CD, type in **D:\2000**, then click **OK**. (Change **D:** to match your CD-ROM drive letter)
5. Check **Install one of the other drivers**, click **Next**.
6. Select **SIIG CyberPro 1P PCI board (Windows 2000)**, click **Next**.
7. Click **Finish**.
8. Restart Windows to complete the installation.

Windows XP

1. At the **Found New Hardware Wizard**, select **Install from a list or specific location (Advanced)**, then click **Next**.

2. Insert the driver CD, check **Include this location in the search**, uncheck the other check box, type in **D:\XP**, and click **Next**. (Change **D:** to match your CD-ROM drive letter)
3. Select **SIIG CyberPro 1P PCI board(Windows XP/2003)**, then click **Next**.
4. If the **Hardware Installation** window pops up, click **Continue Anyway**, then **Finish**. *Our driver has been thoroughly tested for stability and compatibility.*
5. Restart Windows to complete the installation.

Windows Server 2003

1. At the **Found New Hardware Wizard**, select **Install from a list or specific location (Advanced)**, then click **Next**.
2. Insert the driver CD, check **Include this location in the search**, uncheck the other check box, type in **D:\2003**, and click **Next**. (Change **D:** to match your CD-ROM drive letter)
3. Select **SIIG CyberPro 1P PCI board(Windows XP/2003)**, then click **Next**.
4. If the **Hardware Installation** window pops up, click **Continue Anyway**, then **Finish**. *Our driver has been thoroughly tested for stability and compatibility.*
5. Restart Windows to complete the installation.

To Verify Windows 2000/XP/Server 2003 Installation

1. Right click **My Computer**, click **Manage**, then click **Device Manager**.
2. Click on the + (plus sign) in front of **Ports (COM & LPT)**, **SIIG CyberPro 1P PCI board...** should be displayed.
