Introduction

The *Bluetooth Wireless Keyboard* is an Ultra-thin keyboard with ultra-comfort keypad.

Installing the Batteries

- 1. Remove the battery cover from the back of the keyboard.
- 2. Insert the 2 AAA batteries and replace the battery cover.

Pairing Keyboard with iPad/iPhone

- 1. Turn the keyboard On and press the **Connect** button to activate the keyboard into pairing mode.
- 2. On your device, go to **Settings**, then select **General** where the Bluetooth settings is located.
- 3. Select **Bluetooth On** for the device to start searching for the keyboard. **Note**: You may need to press the keyboard's Connect button again.
- 4. Once the device finds the keyboard, select Bluetooth Wireless Keyboard from the list.
- 5. Follow the on-screen instructions to enter the PIN code from the keyboard and press **Enter** to complete the pairing. The keyboard is now connected to your device.

Pairing Keyboard with Computer

- 1. Turn the keyboard On and press the **Connect** button to activate the keyboard into pairing mode.
- 2. From your computer, double-click on the **System** icon from the desktop and select **Application**, then **System Preferences**.
- 3. Click on **Bluetooth** from Internet & Wireless category, then click on **Set Up New Device** for the computer to start searching for the keyboard. **Note**: you may need to press the keyboard's Connect button again.
- 4. Once the computer finds the keyboard, highlight Bluetooth Wireless Keyboard and click **Continue**.
- 5. Follow the on-screen instructions to enter the passkey and click **Continue** to complete the pairing.
- 6. The keyboard is now connected to your computer successfully.
