


Full-Motion Monitor Desk Mount - 13" to 27" Installation Instructions

Unpacking

- Carefully remove the contents and lay out on cardboard or other protective surface
- Check package contents against the parts list to ensure that all components were received undamaged. Do not use damaged or defective parts
- Carefully read all instructions before attempting installation



Installation

Caution: This monitor desk mount must be securely attached to the horizontal desktop. If the mount is not properly installed it may fall, resulting in possible injury and/or damage.

1A) C Clamp Installation Install the C-clamp brace (b) to the 35mm Tube Support (a) using 3 C-clamp brace bolts (d), see Figure 1. 2. Install the C-clamp (c) to the 35mm Tube Support assembly according to the thickness of the desktop. The thickness can be changed in three positions. Connect it using 2 M10x15 Bolts (n) and tighten using the Allen Key (o). Tighten the C-clamp to the desktop using the 2 eye bolts, see Figure 2. a а b 0 0 C Figure 1 Figure 2

1B) Existing Grommet Hole Installation

If the existing grommet hole comes with a plastic protector, remove it to ensure a flat surface before installing the desk mount.

- 1. Thread the 3/8" Grommet bolt (f) into the center screw hole located on the bottom of the 35mm Tube Support (a). Turn the grommet bolt so that the top is protruding approximately 1/4" above the screw hole.
- 2. Position the 35mm Tube Support (a) on the mounting surface and secure using the Grommet plate (g) and Wing nut (h), see Figure 3.

1C) Self Drilled Grommet Hole Installation

- 1. Position the 35mm Tube Support (a) on the mounting surface and mark the center hole. Remove the tube support. Drill a 3/8" (10mm) diameter hole at the marked position through the mounting surface.
- 2. Thread the 3/8" Grommet bolt (f) into the center screw hole located on the bottom of the 35mm Tube Support (a). Turn the grommet bolt so that the top is protruding approximately 1/4" above the screw hole.
- 3 Place the tube support on the mounting surface and secure using the Grommet plate (g) and Wing nut (h), see Figure 4.



2. Install the Vesa Plate with Arm (e) to the tube support, make sure the wire clips are on the bottom. Tighten the clamp bolt using the Allen Key (0), see Figure 5.

Caution: When installing the VESA Plate with Arm (e), DO NOT over tighten the clamp bolt. The VESA Plate with Arm is intended to rotate (360 degrees) and is not meant to be attached in a fixed position. Tighten the bolt only tight enough to keep the VESA Plate with Arm at the desired height position. Over tightening the bolt may result in damage to the clamp.







- 3. Mount the monitor to the Vesa plate.
 - 3-1. For flat back monitors use M4x12 Bolt (i) and M4 Washer (k).




Flat Back Monitor



Curved Back Monitor


4. Adjust the height and install the Wire Clips (m).






Install Wire Clips

5. Check the tightness, arrange the cables through the wire clips, and make any final adjustments. Note: Remove the plastic covers at each position to access the tightening screws.
