

Hardware Installation

Note: For low profile systems, replace the currently mounted bracket with the included low profile bracket.

General instructions for installing the card are provided below, since the design of computer cases and motherboards vary. Refer to your computer's reference manual for further information, if needed.

Static Electricity Discharge may permanently damage your system. Discharge any static electricity build up in your body by touching your computer case for a few seconds. Avoid any contact with internal parts and handle cards only by their external edges.

- 1. Turn OFF the power to your computer and any other connected peripheral devices. Unplug the power cord.
- 2. Remove your computer cover and install the card in an available PCI slot.
- 3. Carefully align the card to the selected PCI slot, push the board down firmly, but gently, until it is well seated.

- 4. Replace the slot bracket holding screw to secure the card.
- 5. Connect the PS/2 keyboard and/or mouse to the appropriate PS/2 connector.
- 6. Replace the computer cover and reconnect the power cord.

Driver Installation

Just install the board and Windows will automatically detect and install the correct drivers for it. No additional driver is necessary.

To Verify Windows Installation

The only way to verify the board works is actually connecting a device to the PS/2 port.

Note: Keyboard or mouse cannot be use in DOS using a bootable disk or for entering the system BIOS. It is not supported.
