



Micro USB Connectivity Adapter for Galaxy Installation Guide

Introduction

The *Micro USB Connectivity Adapter for Galaxy* easily imports photos, videos, music and other files onto Micro USB equipped Galaxy devices.

Features and Benefits

- LED activity indicator for Host/SD/MicroSD
- Micro USB Port and included cable provide extra power needed for external hard drives
- Supports SD / MMC / MicroSD / Micro SDHC memory card formats

Layout

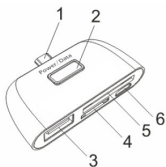


Figure 1: Layout

1. **Micro USB Connector (male):** Connects to your Galaxy device's Micro USB connector
2. **LED Indicator:**
 - Green: The *Connectivity Adapter* is active
 - Red: Indicates SD or MicroSD inserted
3. **USB Type A:** Connects to your digital camera, USB drive, external hard drive, keyboard or mouse
4. **MicroSD Card Slot:** Connects to your MicroSD card
5. **SD Card Slot:** Connects to your SD card
6. **Micro USB Port (female):** Provides extra power needed for external hard drives

Warning: The *Micro USB Connectivity Adapter for Galaxy* only supports **ONE** device connection at any one time. Inserting more than one device is not supported.

Using USB Drive or Digital Camera

1. Connect your USB drive or Digital Camera to the *Micro USB Connectivity Adapter for Galaxy's* **USB Type A** connector.
2. Connect the *Micro USB Connectivity Adapter for Galaxy's* **Micro USB Connector** to the Galaxy device's **Micro USB** connector. The green LED will light up.
3. The Galaxy device will recognize the USB drive or the Digital Camera. It will read the picture and video files automatically.
4. The files will be located in **/My files/.../UsbDriveA**. **Note:** The path may vary according to the OS version installed.
5. Select the file(s) that you want. Either click on the filename to view or select the specific files and then choose the desired operation (**Send Via, Copy, Cut, Delete, or Rename/Details**).

Warning: The *Micro USB Connectivity Adapter for Galaxy* only supports **ONE** device connection at any one time. Inserting more than one device is not supported.

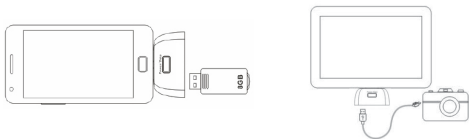


Figure 2: Connecting USB Drive or Digital Camera

Using SD or MicroSD Card

1. Connect the *Micro USB Connectivity Adapter for Galaxy's Micro USB Connector* to the Galaxy device's **Micro USB** connector. The green LED will light up.
2. **SD:** Insert memory card with the gold pins facing down into the SD slot. The green LED will turn to red.
MicroSD: Insert memory card with the gold pins facing up into the MicroSD slot. The green LED will turn to red.
3. The Galaxy device will recognize the memory card. It will read the picture and video files automatically.
4. The files will be located in **/My files/.../UsbDriveA**. **Note:** The path may vary according to the OS version installed.

5. Select the file(s) that you want. Either click on the filename to view or select the specific files and then choose the desired operation (**Send Via, Copy, Cut, Delete, or Rename/Details**).

Warning: The *Micro USB Connectivity Adapter for Galaxy* only supports **ONE** device connection at any one time. Inserting more than one device is not supported.

Using an External Hard Drive

The included **Micro USB Cable** supplies extra power to external hard drives when needed. Please disconnect your external hard drive from the *Micro USB Connectivity Adapter for Galaxy* before connecting the **Micro USB Cable**.

1. Connect the included **Micro USB Cable** between the *Micro USB Connectivity Adapter for Galaxy's* **Micro USB Port** and any USB wall charger or computer's USB port.
2. Connect your external hard drive to the *Micro USB Connectivity Adapter for Galaxy's* **USB Type A** connector.
3. Connect the *Micro USB Connectivity Adapter for Galaxy's* **Micro USB Connector** to the Galaxy device's **Micro USB** connector. The green LED will light up.
4. The Galaxy device will recognize the external hard drive and read the files automatically. The files will be located in / **My files/.../UsbDriveA**. **Note:** The path may vary according to the OS version installed.
5. Select the file(s) that you want. Either click on the filename to view or select the specific files and then choose the desired operation (**Send Via, Copy, Cut, Delete, or Rename/Details**).

Warning: The *Micro USB Connectivity Adapter for Galaxy* only supports **ONE** device connection at any one time. Inserting more than one device is not supported.

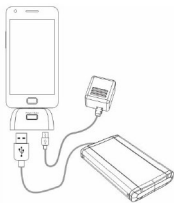


Figure 4: Connecting External Hard Drive

Using a USB Keyboard and Mouse

1. Connect your USB keyboard or mouse to the *Micro USB Connectivity Adapter for Galaxy's* **USB Type A** connector.
2. Connect the *Micro USB Connectivity Adapter for Galaxy's* **Micro USB Connector** to the Galaxy device's **Micro USB** connector. The green LED will light up.
3. Your keyboard or mouse is ready to use.

Warning: The *Micro USB Connectivity Adapter for Galaxy* only supports **ONE** device connection at any one time. Inserting more than one device is not supported.
